Project Description

Cole High School will become Cole Adult Ministries Center. This building will house McCurdy Ministries Community Center (MMCC) administrative offices, two adult education spaces and a computer lab, a literacy coaching classroom, childcare space, a community room, a McCurdy history gallery, a dining space and a warm up kitchen.

MMCC is collaborating with Northern New Mexico College to provide adult education classes in this building starting in October of 2017. We are planning a collaboration with Rio Arriba Adult Literacy Program for adult literacy coaching in the building. Quality childcare will be provided by MMCC at no cost to students participating in these programs removing a barrier to adults seeking education.

In addition, there will be a Community Room and History Gallery. The Community Room will be open to the community for events and the History Room will honor our 105 years of McCurdy missionaries, alumni and staff serving God in the Espanola Valley.
